Be able to **Maintain** most of the **Information ourselves**

Future Expandability (for internal use, possibly for sales of CDs and books, etc)

Please access the Web-site, by typing our web-address (www.lobethalharmonyclub.com.au) into the top field of your web-browser or type 'Lobethal Harmony Club' into the search field. We are now on the first page of Google search and organisations which are ranked above us - sacommunity.org or Australian National Choral Association (ANCA) - have links to our web-site. So we can be found now.

There are three pages which we cannot edit directly (Home, Events, Contact us) all the rest was designed and entered by me. Since English is not my first language, I would like to ask the members, and in particular the Web-site committee, to review, correct language, etc and put comments and suggestions for improvements to me (manfred@sq.com.au), preferably in electronic format. I suggest we have a **Web-site Committee meeting on Tue June 27th at 7:00 pm** in the Hall.

On the 'Events' page we have created 3 sections – Concerts, Social Activities and Club Functions, Prelim. Schedule for next Year. All info shown can be easily edited/modified by me and I can train anybody who is interested to perform this task. I am happy to maintain it also. Can everybody, especially the Concert Planning Committee, please keep me up to date regards to this information and also check the info for correctness. Thanks.

The info on the 'Contact us' page can also be changed by us, not the layout. For feedback, please contact me.

Many pages are just a first go and I am waiting for additional information, especially regards to Chor Farmer, Officers and Club History. Scholarship is pretty much up to date and the Newsletters and Past Concerts have been updated regularly.

We had planned to revise the content, text and layout of the HOME page, at the end of the project. We have full control over the pictures with text that are shown at the top (new feature), however the web-designer has to do the rest and I would like to have only one go on this. I would like to achieve agreement during the meeting on the 27th, so please forward your suggestions to me well ahead.

So, this web-site has been my baby and it had its birth now, but I would like to achieve that most members, or at least those who use computers or smartphones regularly, see it as **THEIR WEB-SITE** as well. So please provide the support required. Thank you.

I suggest we should get the web-site a bit settled before looking into future enhancements. Next year is our 140 year jubilee and the website can be used to promote this milestone.
