We were introduced to special organ skills— one being "thumbing down" (playing with one hand on two keyboards at the same time), and we were left with a delightful rendition of "Danny Boy". which was like listening to the singing of angels.

**Executive report.....** We held our meeting last Tuesday, where we could discuss openly without the restrictions of covid was good.
