

From Chris.....Our church at Springhead Lutheran sends a Mission team once a year to Thailand to assist the local churches with building, improving their church property. All the fundraising is done here in Australia before we go and all members of the team fund their own trip! We usually have a good idea of what we will be doing as there is good communication with the Lutheran Church in Thailand before we travel. The time we spend is approx. 2 weeks, and they also have backup in case there are problems with the original plan. We were in the highlands of Nan area approx. 5kms from the Laos border. We travelled every day from a small town called Ban Sapa up the mountain in a 4 door utility. Then we walked approx. 300 m down to the church location. The work involved brick laying, rendering, window and door fixing and also planned tiling but we ran out of time. Our team numbered 4 and we had another 10 people from other local churches. It was an amazing time.
