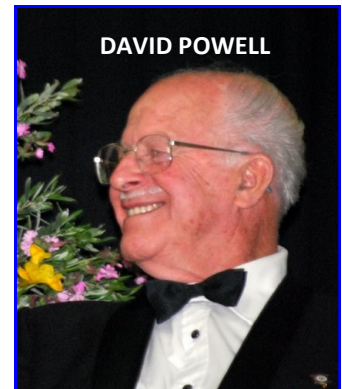


LUKE ZANKER

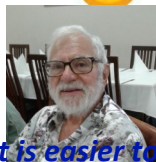
