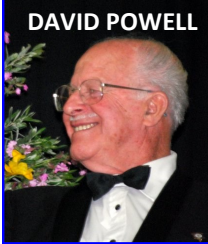

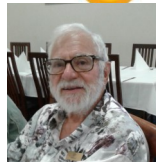

Last week we read about Luke's involvement to raise money for the Leukaemia foundation.

He explains a few weeks ago my wife Chari-lee returned from work upset, learning that our family friends (Tim and Aimee) young son Tom was in

hospital. Tom was later diagnosed with Leukaemia, after suffering multiple brain haemorrhages. This has affected his movement and speech. Tom faces the uphill battle of chemotherapy and all the affects that go with it, while also rehabilitating from the brain haemorrhages. The courage this young boy will need to battle on in the coming months is beyond anything I could muster. When I heard about Tom's situation, it really played on the heart strings and after much thought and peayer, I knew I needed to do something to help. I am hoping I can raise \$5,000 to donate to the Leukaemia Foundation, with the generosity of my family and friends; along with the vast Elders network and suppliers.
