Alongside all these issues, we are ready to welcome any new members into the Club, to join with us in the joy of singing and the great camaraderie that we share together.



From Alex.....Happy New Year, I'm looking forward to getting back to Lobethal for some singing. As requested here is where things stand with my surgery. I have completed all the work-up and assessments required and am

waiting for the final assessments which involves surgeons, nephrologists and nurses all reviewing my results and hopefully approving me for transplant. If I am approved the surgery will almost certainly not happen before late May. They will definitely need to remove one of my native kidneys and it's possible that this will be done separately. This would mean two operations approximately 3 months apart. I also don't know how long I have to be away after each operation, but I do know I won't be allowed to drive for 6 weeks after each opera-
